CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

- 1.1 The competition is open to players who are members of an affiliated golf club within the counties of Bedfordshire, Cambs & Hunts, Essex, Hertfordshire, Norfolk and Suffolk, who have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status. Rules of the R&A Rules Limited and who hold a Competition CONGU handicap at the date of entry.

Regulations

- 2.1 Entries shall be limited to 50 players.
- 2.2 Entry forms accompanied by the appropriate fee must reach the organiser by the closing date of 12th June 2017.
- 2.3 In the event of entries exceeding 50 players the latest player at the time of application will be kept on a reserve list.
- 2.4 The competition draw will be made after 12th June 2017 and published on BLCGA & East Region websites
- 2.5 Competitors **MUST** register at the Registration Desk **no later than 30 minutes before their first tee time.**
- 2.6 A current Competition CONGU Handicap must be held by the player. Failure to have this will mean disqualification.
- 2.7 All players must be over 50 years of age from on 10th July 2017.
- 2.8 The organiser has the authority to arrange / alter tee times.
- 2.9 In the event of adverse conditions, the organiser reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- 3 A player withdrawing after the closing date **MUST inform the organiser Mrs. Kim Burnage Tel: 01525 223032 or email: kim.burnage@gmail.com. Entry fees are non-refundable after the closing date** unless the organiser has a substitute.
- 3.1 In all matters, the decision of the organiser is final.

Conditions

- 3.2 The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the club as approved by the organiser.
- 3.3 The competition shall consist of 18 holes stroke play.
- 3.4 In the event of a tie the winners will be decided on a count back basis over the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) on the card .. **Players may only win one prize.**
- 3.5 If a player arrives at their starting point ready to play within five minutes after their starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33.7, the penalty for failure to start on time is **TWO STROKES. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.**
- 3.6 The ball used must be on the R&A Conforming Ball List. The penalty is disqualification.
- 3.7 Distance Measuring Devices may be used.
- 3.8 Competitors should walk at all times during the competition. Use of a buggy will only be permitted with a medical certificate. The penalty is disqualification.
- 3.9 Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. The penalty is disqualification.
- 4 The organiser and referees will monitor the pace of play and will take action under the Rules of Golf if players are considered to be delaying play.
